# SAFETY TOWN 2020

Safety Town instruction is provided by a school teacher along with the Mayfield Heights Police and Fire Departments, Highland Heights Police Department and Mayfield Village Police Department. A school bus, provided by the school system, will be used to show the students all aspects of proper school bus safety. Children will also learn essential elements in such areas as fire safety, stranger safety and poison safety. Children will be expected to learn:

- his/her full name, address and phone number
- how to tell colors and the meaning of a traffic light
- how to recognize a stop sign and its meaning
- how to cross the street with a policeman, school guard and traffic light
- not to accept candy, treats, or rides from strangers
- the correct way to get on and off a school bus and to cross in front of the bus.
- the safety rules of the home – which include:

- DON'T:
- a. go into the medicine cabinet
  - b. take any medicine unless given by Mom or Dad
  - c. play with glass bottles
  - d. play with sharp objects: forks, knives, etc.
  - e. play with the TV controls
  - f. put objects in your mouth – pencils, crayons, etc.
  - g. play with matches or lighters
  - h. play with light switches or electrical cords
  - i. play with sewing machines or any electrical appliances

In addition, the children will be shown a patrol car, ambulance and fire truck and the special equipment on each vehicle.
