



## All School Dress Code

The dress code contributes to a positive learning environment at Corpus Christi Academy ensuring that all students are dressed in a manner that is respectful to themselves and others. Students are expected to abide by the dress code during the school day and at all school events.

- ★ **Clothing may have a CCA logo; otherwise it must have no logo at all. The CCA. Uniform must be worn in a manner that is appropriate for a school environment and must be kept in good condition with no holes, tears, etc.**
- ★ **Summer Uniform:** may be worn from the start of school until September 30th and from May 1st until the last day of school. Summer uniform consists of khaki or navy blue walking shorts and school color polo.
- ★ **On PE days,** students wear PE uniform all day. PE uniforms are purchased through Corpus Christi Academy. Uniform consists of PE t-shirts and shorts during warm weather months and sweatpants after October 1st through the end of April. Shorts may be worn under sweatpants during the school year if students want to participate in gym class in their shorts.
- ★ **On Spirit or House Days,** students may wear any CCA uniform bottom with appropriate spirit day or house color top. This is a chance to show school spirit and wear some of the clothing purchased from the online spirit shop.
- ★ **Shorts and skirts** should be no shorter than one inch above the knee.
- ★ **Sweaters:** Solid white, navy, black, or red sweaters are permitted in cardigan, pullover, vest, or quarter-zip styles. No hoodies, hats, or head coverings are allowed.
- ★ **Shoes:** Shoes must be sturdy and supportive and, for safety reasons, must be closed in front and back. Tennis shoes may be worn every day but must be worn on PE days. Shoes should be a solid one to two colors. No sandals, crocs, ugg slippers, yeezy, moccasins, boots, or ballerina slippers are permitted. Heels of shoes may not be higher than 1 inch.
- ★ **Jewelry:** one pair of non dangling earrings on ear lobe only. No other body piercings are allowed. One necklace, watch and bracelet are allowed. Jewelry cannot be distracting to the learning environment. No tattoos of any kind. Temporary tattoos should be removed before coming to school. NO SMART WATCHES ARE PERMITTED.
- ★ **Students may dress out of uniform** for their birthday or half birthday (for summer birthdays). Students may not dress down on Mass days.
- ★ **No clothing may contain messages or themes** inconsistent with the Gospel or traditions of the Catholic Church, or have references to products and ideas that would be prohibited in school such as tobacco, drugs, guns, violence and alcohol.
- ★ **Administration** has the final discretion on what is appropriate uniform.

## **GIRLS**

### **GIRLS K-3**

**Jumper:** Purchased from Schoolbelles (various styles available)

**Blouse/Polo:** White, Navy, Red, or Light Blue with long or short sleeves and round or pointed collars

**Pants:** Solid Navy Blue or Khaki regular uniform pants (no jeans, jeggings, cargo, yoga, skinny, oversized, etc)

Belts must be worn when pants have belt loops. Belts should be a solid color.

**Socks/Tights:** Solid colors that complement the uniform. Socks should be knee high when worn with jumpers and need to be visible when wearing pants.

**Hair:** Hair should be kept clean, neat, and appropriately styled with no extreme styles or fads. (for example, mohawks, shaved designs, stripes, unnatural colors). Hair cannot obstruct vision or be distracting to the learning environment. Hair accessories that complement the school uniform may be worn.

**Make-up:** No make-up of any kind is allowed. Nail polish may be worn on natural nails.

### **GIRLS 4-8**

**Skirt:** Purchased from Schoolbelles (various styles available) Girls in 4th grade can still wear a jumper.

**Blouse/Polo:** White, Navy, Red, or Light Blue with long or short sleeves and round or pointed collars

**Pants:** Solid Navy Blue or Khaki regular uniform pants (no jeans, jeggings, cargo, yoga, skinny, oversized, etc)

Belts must be worn when pants have belt loops. Belts should be a solid color.

**Socks/Tights:** Solid colors that complement the uniform. Socks should be knee high when worn with jumpers and need to be above the top of shoes when wearing pants.

**Hair:** Hair should be kept clean, neat, and appropriately styled with no extreme styles or fads. (for example, mohawks, shaved designs, stripes, unnatural colors). Hair cannot obstruct vision or be distracting to the learning environment. Hair accessories that complement the school uniform may be worn.

**Make-up:** No make-up of any kind is allowed for girls in grades 4-5. Nail polish may be worn on natural nails. Acrylics not permitted.

\*\*\* Girls in grades 6-8 may wear natural looking make-up.

## **BOYS**

### **BOYS K-8**

**Pants:** Solid Navy Blue or Khaki regular uniform pants (no jeans, jeggings, cargo, yoga, skinny, oversized, etc)

Belts must be worn when pants have belt loops. Belts should be a solid color.

**Shirts/Polos:** White, Navy, Red, or Light Blue with long or short sleeves and round or pointed collars. Button down shirts must be worn with a tie. Ties can be any color or style that is school appropriate.

**Socks:** Solid colors that complement the uniform. Socks need to be visible.

**Hair:** Hair should be kept clean, neat, and appropriately styled with no extreme styles or fads. (for example, mohawks, shaved designs, stripes, unnatural colors). Hair cannot obstruct vision or be distracting to the learning environment.

Face must be clean shaven.
